

Protection Concept for the **Swiss Cup Basel 2021 (October 8-10, 2021)** Curlingzentrum Region Basel (CRB)

Introduction

In view of the current COVID-19 pandemic, the OC wishes to minimize all possible sources of infection and therefore follows the guidelines of the Federal Council and the Canton of Basel-Landschaft, as the safety and health of the players, coaches, attendants and spectators have top priority.

Framework conditions, COVID-certified event

This document contains the protective measures against COVID-19 for the **Swiss Cup Basel 2021**, which will take place from 8 - 10 October 2021 at the CRB in Arlesheim.

In agreement with the CRB board of directors (written authorization has been received), access to the CRB curling hall (including the restaurant Arlésienne) is only permitted to persons with valid COVID-19 vaccination certificate, COVID-19 recovery certificate, persons with a negative PCR test (max. 72 hours) or antigen rapid test (max. 48 hours) in accordance with FOPH specifications.

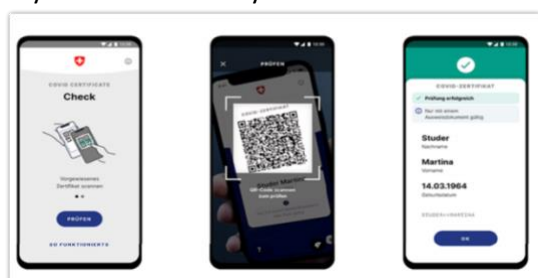
Anyone who cannot present a negative antigen or PCR test or COVID certificate will not be admitted to the CRB.

Persons under 16 years of age are exempt from a COVID certificate obligation (ID required).

There is no possibility for a quick test on site.

The checking will take place in the entrance area where the protection concept will also be clearly visible.

The staff at the entrance control must be equipped with the "COVID Certificate Check" app. The COVID certificate can be presented as a paper document or via electronic COVID certificate in the app. When checking the personal COVID certificate, an identification document with photo (e.g. identity card, passport or driver's license) may be requested. During the verification process, the app does not store any data on central systems or in the "COVID Certificate Check" app:



Observance of hygiene regulations during play

The hygiene regulations of the FOPH must be observed and implemented to guarantee the safety of the participants themselves and of all other persons on site. These are:

1. only symptom-free persons may enter the CRB.
2. keep your distance: as before, it is important to keep 1.5 meters where possible.

Disinfectant dispensers and wipes are available at the entrance and at the links. Players are asked to disinfect their hands before each game. The stone handles will be disinfected by the OC/helpers prior to each match.

Mask obligation

Masks are not mandatory in the curling hall (cloakroom, rinks, spectators areas, catering area).

Gastronomy

The catering of the players, coaches, attendants, staff and spectators is in accordance with the current valid protection concept for the catering industry of Gastro Suisse, implemented by Leo and Nicole Saracista, Restaurant Arlésienne.

Communication to players, coaches, attendants and helpers

The protection and access concepts will be sent to the teams by e-mail. In addition, the concepts will be published on <http://www.swisscupbasel.ch> --> Register COVID-19.


Shuttle service

Masks are mandatory. Free masks and disinfectants will be available on each bus.


